**Maine Trapshooting Association
Dedicates the 2024 State Championships to
Dr. John Kazilionis**



Dr. John Kazilionis has been an avid shooter in Maine since 1989. He has registered over 158,000 targets with a lifetime average in singles of 93.22%; in Handicap of 81.78%; and in Doubles an 81.64%. Vice President of MTA for his first term, he has certainly supported trap shooting in Maine for all involved.

In 2020, Dr. Kazilionis took the initiative, after a meeting with the MTA Executive Board and the SF&GA Trap Executive Committee, to create a document and presentation for the SF&GA Trap committee meeting. His focus was to address shooters' concerns that needed to be dealt with in order to increase attendance. The presentation and document created by Dr. Kazilionis, for that SF&GA Trap Committee meeting, changed the Maine State Shoot forever. Most should understand, if not for this change, there most definitely would not be a State Shoot Championship of today's size in Maine. His efforts and courage to extinguish the previous operating procedures, led to the team effort we have today. Dr. John took a risk by speaking out for the greater good of trap shooting in Maine. For these efforts, Dr. John Kazlionis is recognized for his commitment to strengthening Maine Trapshooting as we know it today.

GENERAL INFORMATION

It is the shooter's responsibility to be informed of the contents of this program and rules governing ATA sanctioned shoots. All shooters must be classified before making their entries. On Championship Singles, target fees for all resident sub juniors and juniors will be reduced by 50%, provided no monies are played.

1. Management reserves the right to reject any entry and make changes to the program.
2. Anyone violating any of the rules may be disqualified and will not share in any prize money or trophies.
3. Shooters and spectators assume all responsibilities for any and all accidents.
4. The MTA president, State ATA Delegate, and designees, will act as a Committee to rule on all disputes.
5. White Flyer Orange Top Pitch Targets will be thrown.
6. All banks will be drawn at random. Event targets will be shot on four banks of two traps each. The "Quick 50" format will be used at the discretion of shoot management and only if necessary.
7. The practice field will be open at 4pm on Wednesday, July 10th and during the tournament from 8am to 4pm. Practice rounds are priced at the Scarborough club's member rate of \$7.00 per round of 25.
8. Trophies will be available for pick up each day and will not be mailed.
9. Cell phones and pagers are not allowed on the line.

10. Campsites and RV Parking are available. Reservations are on a first come first serve basis. Sites include water but no power. Camper access is available July 8th to 15th. Gate codes will be provided. **Contact Darrin Kirkpatrick 207-671-6389 or ddk0580@gmail.com for reservations.**

11. It is the shooter's responsibility to verify their scores on both the scoresheets and the score board. Once purses and options are figured they will not be changed. However; scores will be corrected for record purposes.

12. Strict adherence to ATA and SF&G club rules regarding alcohol, drugs and eye and ear protection will be observed.

13. Ties in singles and doubles on Thursday and Friday will be carried over by sub event to the next like event. Ties in Handicap will be shot off.

14. Special category shooters must declare their category at the time of classification and verify it is indicated on their receipt. Saturday's single classification will determine the High All Around Class.

15. To pre-squad please log on to www.PreSquad.com. Pre-Squad opens on June 2nd and closes on July 5th.

16. There will be a meeting of the MTA membership Sunday between events for the purpose of electing the ATA delegate and Alternate(s). All resident Maine shooters are encouraged to attend.

17. The Scarborough club has ammo for sale to shooters up to the amount they are shooting in this tournament. The cost is \$10.00 per box on a first come first serve basis, until stock is depleted.

18. Classification will be available Wednesday evening (July 10th) from 3pm to 6pm.

Classification

Classification will be based on the last 600 targets, total average or known ability, whichever is higher. Robert Harris, Jr., ATA Delegate, is chairman of the Classification Committee. It is the shooter's responsibility to see that their ATA card is correct and up to date. Falsified cards will result in disqualification. It is the shooters responsibility to make category declaration when classified.

Penalty

Shooters must have at least 600 singles, 500 handicap and 400 doubles for 2023 and 2024 target years combines to avoid penalty classification.

Handicap

Adult male, Junior Gold, Sub Veteran and Veteran shooters not meeting target requirements will be assigned 2 yards over their normal yard age, subject to a 23 yard minimum and a 25 yard maximum. Ladies (1&2), Sub Juniors and Juniors will follow the same rules except the minimum penalty will be 21 yards. There will be no penalty yardage to shooters who are 70 years or older. Any shooter may elect to shoot for targets only and be exempted from penalty yardage. However; said person will not be allowed to play purses or options and forfeits all rights to added monies and trophies.
