

Meeting Minutes

July 27, 2025

Minute Man Sportsman's Club, Burlington, MA

The meeting was called to order at 11:45AM by President Gary Littlefield.

President Littlefield led the pledge of allegiance and welcomed those present.

President Littlefield asked for a moment of silence for all the shooters who had passed away in the prior year.

President Littlefield thanked Phil Wright and Minute Man club staff for hosting the NH State Shoot and commended the club for its excellent shoot operations. President Littlefield thanked the NHTA members who help with classification, entries, target setting and shoot offs. President Littlefield recognized Jason Green for his excellent work as webmaster. He also recognized Allisen Reese for her excellent work in selecting the trophies.

Phil Wright, ATA Delegate, reported that shooting activity nationwide was up marginally through the end of June but that activity in the northeast region has been down. Phil observed that the Massachusetts gun law has led to a 15% drop in MA State Shoot attendance, mainly due to fewer non-resident participants. Phil also mentioned that the incoming ATA President will be Joe Sissano from New Jersey.

Jason Green reported that the two shell raffles netted \$2,000. Jason announced that Kevin Brodeur was the winner of the most recent raffle after Al Smigelski donated the shells back. White Flyer was recognized for donating 5 flats of ammo to support the state shoot. That ammo was sold netting \$450. Jason spoke about the state shoot sponsorship program and the new look of the state shoot program. Jason recognized Allisen Reese and Steve Haynes for donating the 3 belt buckles for non-resident champions.

The hand crafted wooden American flag from Don LeFebvre will be awarded at this year's tournament.

State Team members were recognized. Buckle was awarded to John Vo.

Old Business: None

The election of the ATA delegate and alternates was as follows:

Motions were made and seconded for Phil Wright as ATA delegate and Steve Szczechura as first alternate delegate. There being no further nominations the President directed the Secretary to cast one ballot electing Phil and Steve. Phil Wright motioned and Dick Bombard seconded the nomination of Nick Gibbs as second alternate. Jason Green motioned and Gary Littlefield seconded the nomination of Steve Haynes for second alternate. There being no further nominations, a vote was held with Nick Gibbs being elected.

Phil thanked Jason for taking over the state shoot program.

Best wishes were extended to Felipe Garcia for a speedy recovery from his scheduled heart surgery.
