

Annual Meeting Minutes

President Littlefield called the meeting to order and lead the group in the pledge of allegiance to the flag.

Minutes from the annual meeting held December 7, 2024 and the state shoot meeting held July 27, 2025 had been published earlier. A motion was made by Susan Wright and seconded by Doug Whiton to accept the minutes as written. Passed U.

President Littlefield thanked everyone for their help and support in the past year. President Littlefield thanked Jason Green for his work as webmaster. President Littlefield extended the NHTA's gratitude to those who helped with the state shoot. President also thanked Minute Man Sportsman's Club and its staff for hosting the NH State Shoot. President Littlefield stated that state shoot attendance declined from 2024 because of new restrictions on non-residents passed by Massachusetts.

Treasurer Jack Cannon presented his report. As a result of cost cutting and new sponsorships for the state shoot net income for 2025 was around \$7,500. Cash balance currently stands at approximately \$21,000. Jack thanked Allisen Reese for her efforts in keeping trophy costs within budget.

CORRESPONDENCE

The Secretary reported that a letter had been received from the Trapshooting Hall of Fame thanking the association for its contribution resulting from the Hall of Fame Lewis at the state shoot.

WEBSITE/VP REPORT

Jason Green reported that activity on the website is very good with frequent visits by numerous shooters. Jason thanked those who made the state shoot sponsorship program a success. He singled out Greg Pink from SOS software for sponsoring the Silver Shootout. As a result of everyone's efforts the state shoot was cash positive this year. Jason thanked John Vo for his donation of a TriStar semi-automatic shotgun to the NHTA to be used in some sort of fund raising. The Kittery Trading Post gift card winner was Sue Wright who donated it back with Nick Fenton winning on the subsequent drawing.

DELEGATE'S REPORT

2025 Grand American:

Weather was hot early but cooled off as the week went on.

Attendance was down about 4% from 2024.

7 NH Shooters attended. Steve Haynes, Allisen Reese, Mike and Theresa Blaisdell, Phil and Sue Wright and Nick Gibbs.

ATA Business:

The ATA's financial condition remains very solid.

Registered targets thrown from September through June were down about 4.2% from 2024.

25% of all targets registered are shot by members under 23.

Satellite Grands were down 9% and State Shoots were down 4% from 2024.

Number of active members 55 and older is 10,588.

ATA membership is stable at around 61,000. ATA registered targets thrown in 2023 and 2024 totaled almost 50,000,000 each year and it appears that 2025 will be slightly lower.

AIM4NH REPORT

Missy Riley submitted a written report. AIM4NH is now a registered 501c (3) not for profit charity. Any contributions made to the organization are now tax deductible. AIM4NH is looking for a club in NH to host the AIM NH State Shoot. Concern over the new MA restrictions for bringing firearms into the state is the reason.

The State Team for 2026 was announced with 25 qualifying. Buckles and certificates will be awarded at the July meeting.
